

RESOLUTION No. 5

WHEREAS, A core principal of representative democracy is that those who are represented have the right to know how their representatives vote; therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED That Article 19, Section 3 of AFM Bylaws be amended, as follows:

2 Candidates seeking election to any Federation Office may only be nominated by a
3 Convention delegate at the Convention. Only members in good standing may be nominated. No
4 member may be nominated for more than one Office. The time of nominations and election of
5 Officers shall be designated by the Convention not later than the first day it is in session. A
6 correct copy of the names of all nominees shall be furnished to each Delegate and the election
7 shall be conducted in accordance with the Australian ballot system, except that the voting shall
8 be by Role Call vote and not by secret ballot. Nominating speeches by Delegates shall be
9 limited to two minutes each.
